deixando seca e ligante

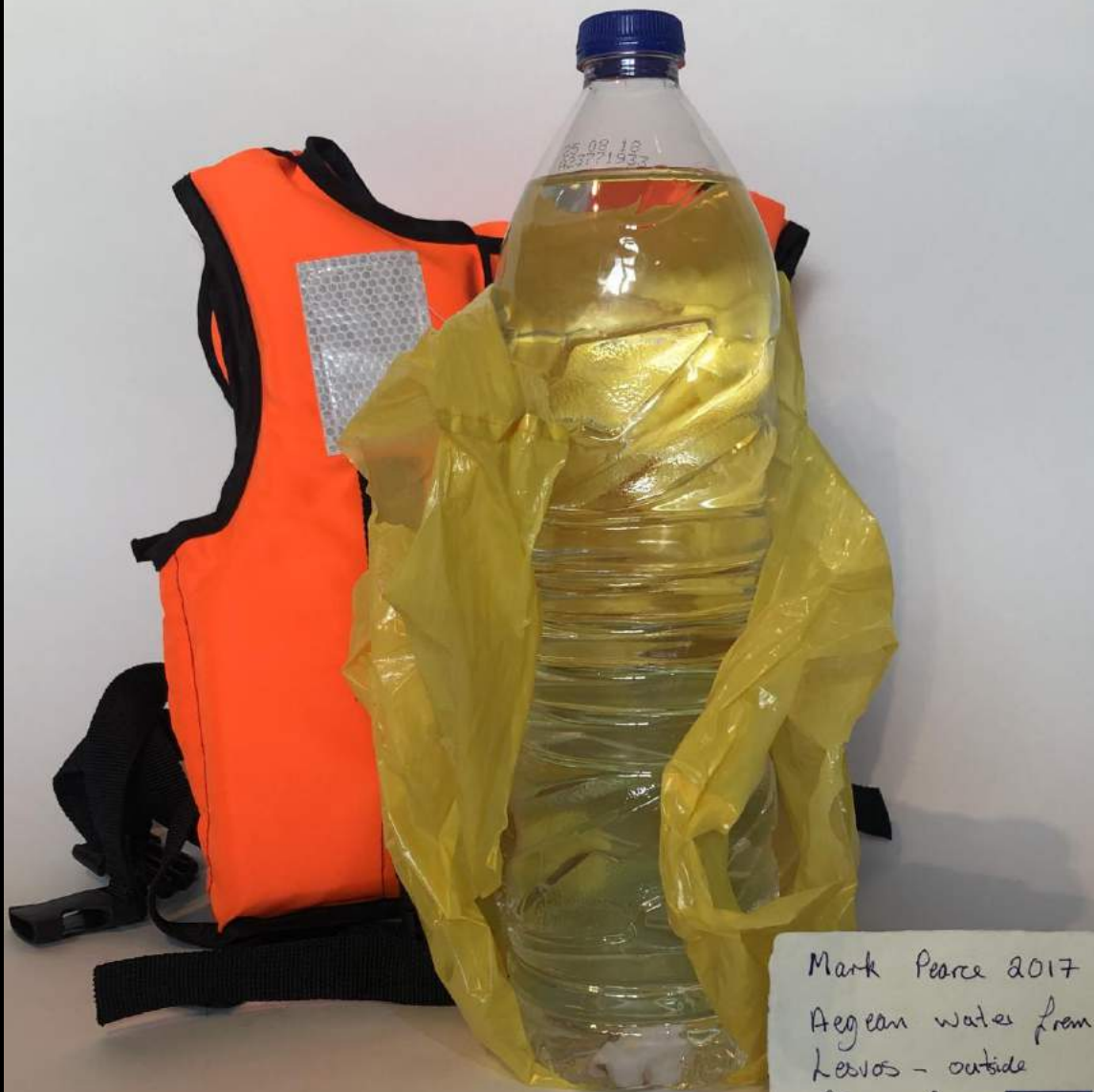

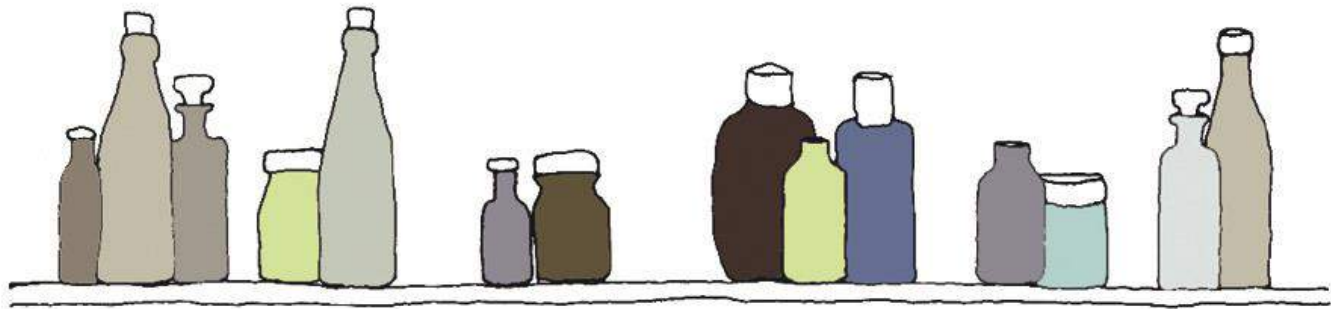

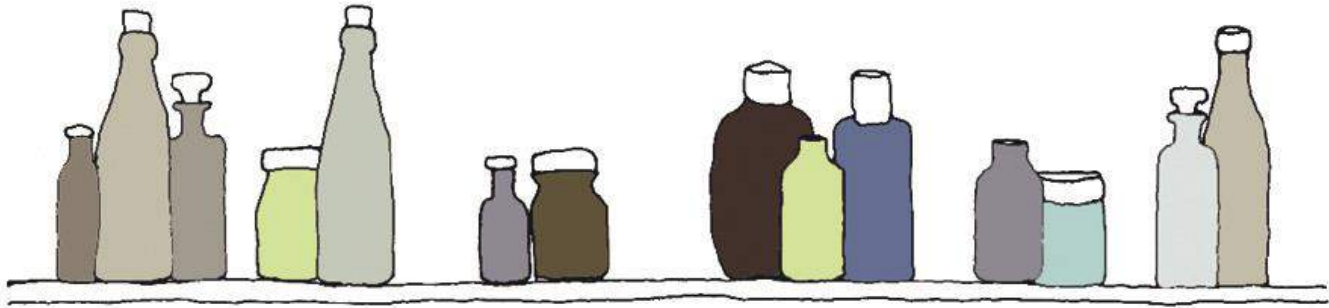
