PRESS RELEASE

After reviewing all artworks submitted to the 2nd edition of the **International Youth Prize Contest #The Water We Want**, the Global Network of Water Museums is pleased to announce the **winners and special mentions** of this year's competition. The COVID pandemic did not stop the brave students, teachers and schools that decided to participate to the contest and sent even this year, despite global restrictions, thousands of beautiful artworks.

Among drawings, videos, photos, songs and other works, all entries submitted to the competition by 6-18 years old youth were selected by 23 water museums affiliated to the Global Network. The 89 pre-selected works are now featured in the online Digital Exhibition #TheWaterWeWant: http://thewaterwewant.watermuseums.net/

Artworks sent by young generations highlight, from different perspectives and through different media, the fragile nature of water and the need to cherish this fundamental resource for life. Preventing further pollution and waste and mitigating impacts of climate change are today the urgent imperative to stop the dramatic consequences of the global water crises and the continuous loss of freshwater biodiversity.

Many young and talented participants reflected on the dense layers of local history encapsulated by cultural and natural liquid assets, confirming how crucial they are to inspire today new perceptions, attitudes, visions, and ideas for better preserving this crucial resource.

The youth contest is organised by the **Global Network of Water Museums**: a "flagship initiative" of UNESCO-IHP (Intergovernmental Hydrological Programme) to explore our rich and multifaceted water heritage from the perspective of young people and promote **a new "culture of water" on a global scale**.
