**Humanitarian Emergency State in Burkina Phaso Call for support** to the Musée de l'Eau (new Working Group to coordinate WAMUNET support?) Le Burkina Faso est en proie au **terrorisme** depuis 6 ans. Dans la nuit du **vendredi 4 au samedi 5 juin**, 200 terroristes à moto ont **attaqué le village de Solhan dans le Sahel** du Burkina Faso. Ils ont pillé et brulé le village de 2 heures à 6 heures du matin tuant hommes, femmes, femmes en grossesse, enfants; personnes âgées ou vulnérables...

## Analysis of the situation and risks

#### The post-COVID scenario is making WAMU-NET more and more vulnerable

Without revenues from projects, the network can not be operational for institutional activities. Memberships' revenues alone are not enough (e.g.: for managing the TWWW contest, etc).

This year, it is only thanks to the new video commissioned by our member HYDRIA (Greece) that the 2021 Budget will not suffer consistent loss.




