

1992, October 14 – Establishment of the Water Museum with the occasion of the Company's Centennial Anniversary in the building of the first pumping station of Cluj Water Works.






In 2003 Someş Water established an Educational Program on water sources and environment protection for children and youth






















Activities within the Museum based educational program include, but not restricted to:

- Open lessons about water source protection and environment sustainability at the Museum, Water Purification and WWT Plants, or at the schools
- Plantation of trees/plants (water sources areas)
 - Voluntary cleaning of water source areas
 - Creativity activities/competitions on water/environment topics







Educational activities take place outdoor or indoor







The outdoor section serve also as educational playground for the children









Seizing the period with suspended activity due to the pandemic and the Museum ongoing renovation, an adjacent building to the Museum is currently modernized and prepared to be transformed into education laboratories for children (physics and chemistry, art creation and Virtual Reality and 3D water







- ✓ Funding for the Museum is provided by Someş Water
 - ✓ Entrance is free of charge
- ✓ Running of the educational program and of the Museum is done with Company staff (Communication Division)
 - ✓ Decision making on museum operation and development is done by Someş Water upper management









- The Museum is located in a sanitary highly restricted access area (water source area)
- No staff of it's own all educational, guiding, maintenance activities are carried out by the Company's PR/other staff
 - Staff is not trained in running museum; staff has limited teaching training





Social Responsibility





First, the Museum was established to honor the work of all those who along the 130 years of Someş Water strived to bring the WATER into households and to educate future generations on the value of WATER.

Later, the Museum and it's educational program become the prime mean to better link Somes Water with the communities serviced in observance of it's Social Responsibility policy: to raise awareness and to educate all users but mainly children and youth to behave in order to ensure environmental sustainability, water source protection thus contributing to the objectives of UN's Agenda 2030, mainly of SDG no. 6.



Social Responsibility





As a public utility, Someş Water is the most important regional agent for local development, more than 630 Million Euro worth of investments were spent since 1997 for the modernization and expansion of the regional water and sewage network, water purification and waste water treatment plants.

Through it's Museum and the educational program, Someş Water became the most important agent for awareness raising and education on Water and Environment, especially for future generations.
